You will take part in lots of fun activities when you start, to help you get to know each other and your teachers.


Finding your way around

When you join us, your days will be packed full of interesting and exciting new things to study.


Each day you will have six lessons of 50 minutes each. You will move between classrooms for different subjects and also have specialist, expert teachers for each subject. You will usually stay with some of your Tutor Group friends for your lessons.

What about homework?

You will also get about three to five hours of homework a week. This may sound daunting but don't worry – you will get lots of support with this as well. Your homework will all be on the online portal 'GO4SCHOOLS' so it is easy to keep track of.

Dance and Drama

We have Dance and Drama studios which have professional-level facilities.

Bourne Community Leisure Centre is on our school grounds and we use its brilliant facilities for PE lessons and sports.

Canteen




Trips


Additional needs
